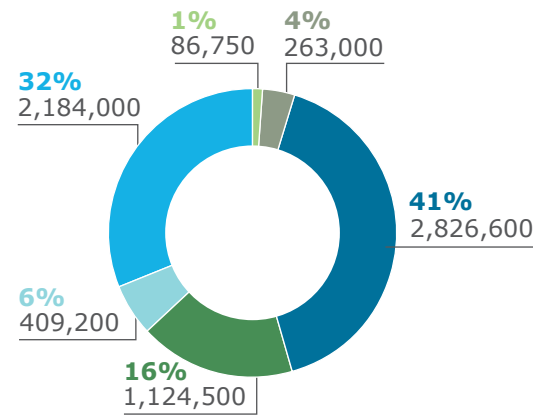

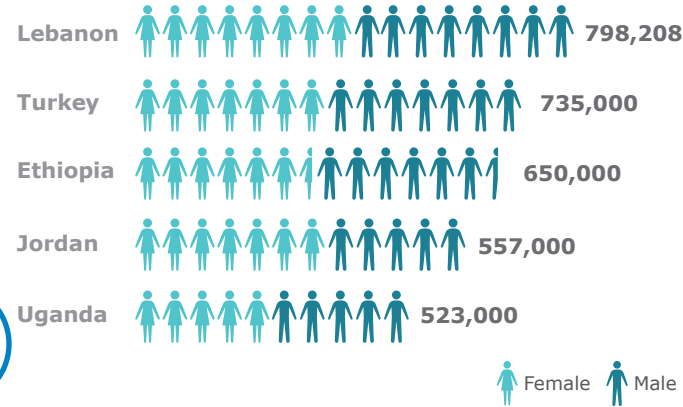
REFUGEES SUPPORTED BY WFP BY REGION*



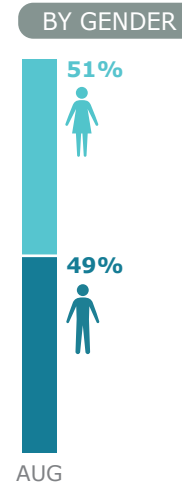

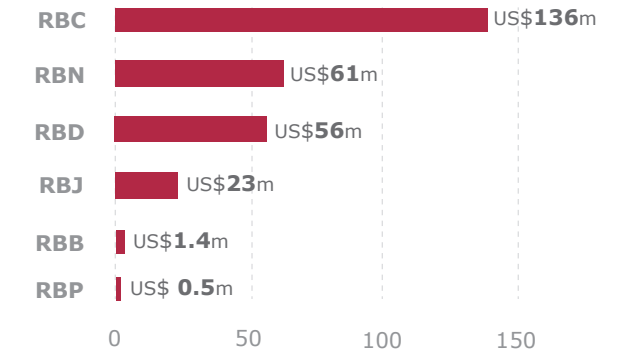

WFP aims to assist nearly **7 million refugees** through operations in **32 countries** (almost 10 percent of WFP's total beneficiaries assisted)



21.3 million Registered Refugees Globally (UNCHR, 2015)

including 11 million child refugees and asylum-seekers. (UNICEF, Sept. 2016)

WFP has **3** Emergency Operations (EMOPs) and **15** Protracted Relief and Recovery Operations (PRROs) that focus primarily on assistance to refugees
