NATURE OF THE INCREASE

1. This revision proposes a one month no-cost extension in time for the EMOP 200966 with a revised project end date of 30 November 2016.

JUSTIFICATION FOR THE REVISION

- 2. EMOP 200966 is implemented in close coordination with the United Nations Resident Coordination Office (UNRCO) and National Disaster Centre (NDC). As per the EMOP plan, a lessons learned workshop and final assessment were identified as crucial activities before the end date of the project.
- 3. Due to changes in the food distribution arrangements, WFP had to step-up and implement direct distributions, due to which the EMOP incurred close to two months of delay in the completion of planned distributions.
- 4. Additionally, the UNRCO and NDC could not agree on lesson learned dates in October 2016, which has forced WFP to re-plan its lesson learned workshop and assessment activities, which require all stakeholder participation. The revised dates for both activities is now planned for November 2016
- 5. The one month project extension is requested to allow the project additional time to complete the above mentioned activities where the added time does not increase the total project planned costs.
