#### NATURE OF THE INCREASE

1. This budget revision proposes a two-month extension in time - at no cost - from 2<sup>nd</sup> November to 31<sup>st</sup> December 2016, to the regional IR EMOP 201030 "Assistance to Victims of Hurricane Matthew in the Caribbean." This extension will enable WFP to reach the planned beneficiaries with high-energy biscuits (HEBs) and to continue providing technical assistance to countries affected by Hurricane Matthew in the region.

#### JUSTIFICATION FOR THE REVISION

## Summary of existing project activities

- 2. In this first month of implementation, the regional bureau, completed the following activities:
  - a. Deployment of emergency surge team composed of programme, supply chain and management staff to Haiti, in order to assist in the strategic response as well as in the food assistance management, and support supply chain processes and coordination with other humanitarian actors.
  - b. Thirty (30) mt of HEB have been airlifted from Dubai to Miami and then to Haiti for further dispatch in the field locations, in particular in those very remote areas which are still unaccessible by road.
  - c. Five (5) Mobile Storage Units (MSU) have been dispatched from Panama UNHRD Hub to Baracoa and Maisí (Cuba) to protect the food destined to assist the most affected population, as well as to strengthen local storage capacities.
  - d. Prefabs and accessories (air conditioner, ancillaries, generator, etc.), tarpaulins and visibility materials have been purchased and dispatched from Panama UNHRD to Haiti.
  - e. Other non-food items (SCOPE registration kit, Satphones, etc.) are being purchased.
- 3. The Regional Bureau, through the IR-EMOP, has also supported field missions carried out by the Cuba Country Office to accompany the Government in their logistics and programmatic assessments.

#### Conclusion and recommendation

4. 30 MT of HEBs have been purchased and airlifted from Dubai to Port-Au-Prince (Haiti) to be distributed to the most affected population in remote and difficult to access areas. WFP Haiti country office (CO) elaborated a distribution plan and already dispatched 20 MT. However, due to current security issues, that could be even further exacerbated during the presidential elections scheduled on 20<sup>th</sup> November, the distribution cannot be completed by the current project end date.
