Mr. Milton Rondó, career diplomat Minister, is the Coordinator-General of International Actions in the Fight Against Hunger in the Ministry of Foreign Relations. In that position, he reports directly to the Secretary-General of Foreign Relations and oversees Brazilian foreign policy for food security, rural development and nutrition, including humanitarian action. In so doing, and as a member of the National Council of Food Security and Nutrition (CONSEA), Mr. Rondó articulates actions and policies with several government ministries, agencies and forums, including the Ministry of Social Development, the Ministry of Rural Development, the Ministry of Agriculture, and others, aside from the Foreign Ministry's own Brazilian Agency for Cooperation (ABC).

In his career, Mr. Rondó has occupied several positions in the Ministry, both in the capital and abroad. He has also occupied lead positions in the Presidency of the Republic and in the State of Rio Grande do Sul related to international cooperation and grass roots communication with civil society.
