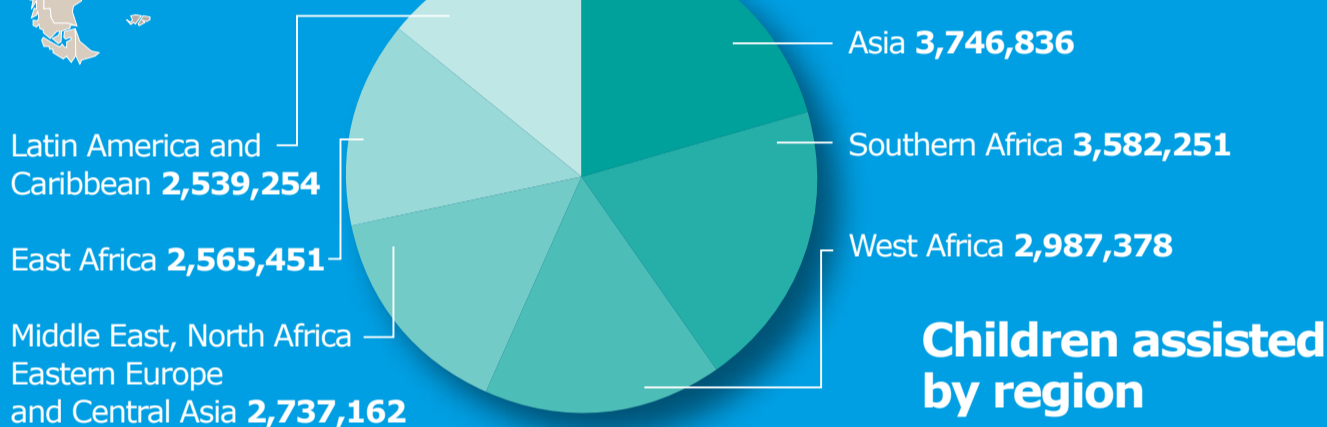
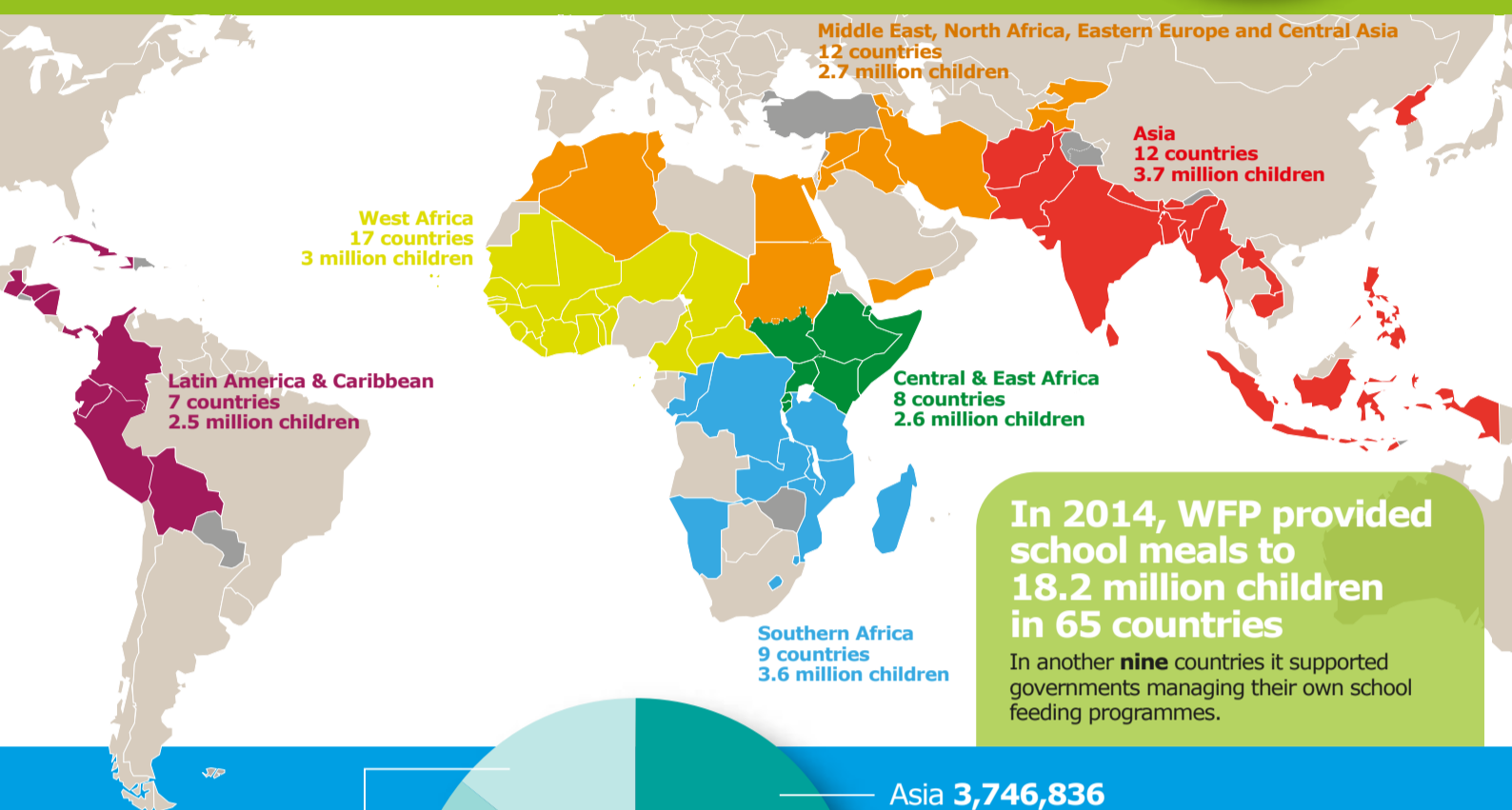
Children fed **18.2 million\***

## 27 countries have home grown school feeding programmes, linking school feeding to local agriculture
