



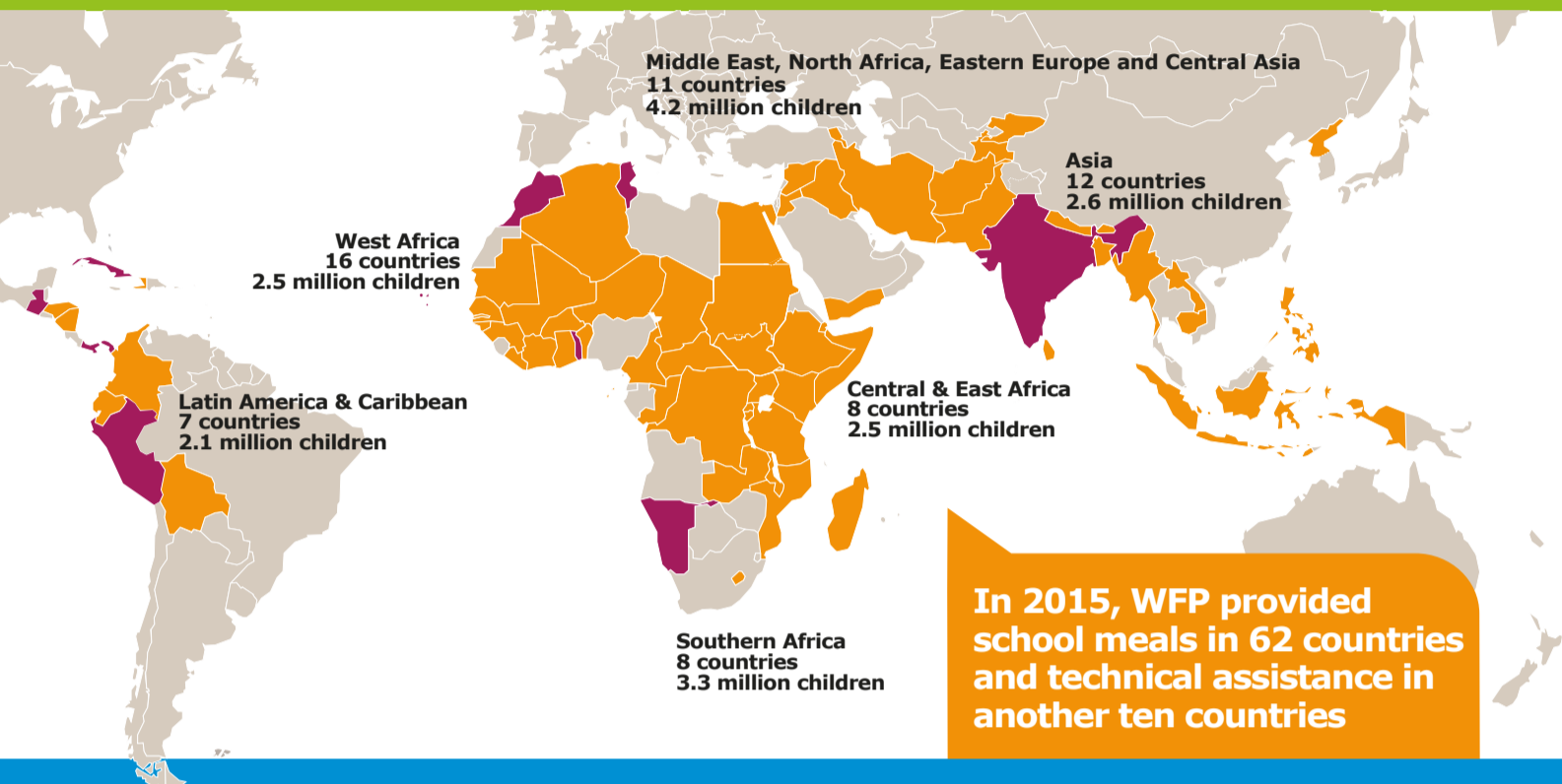
World Food Programme School Meals in 2015

Children fed: 17.4 million

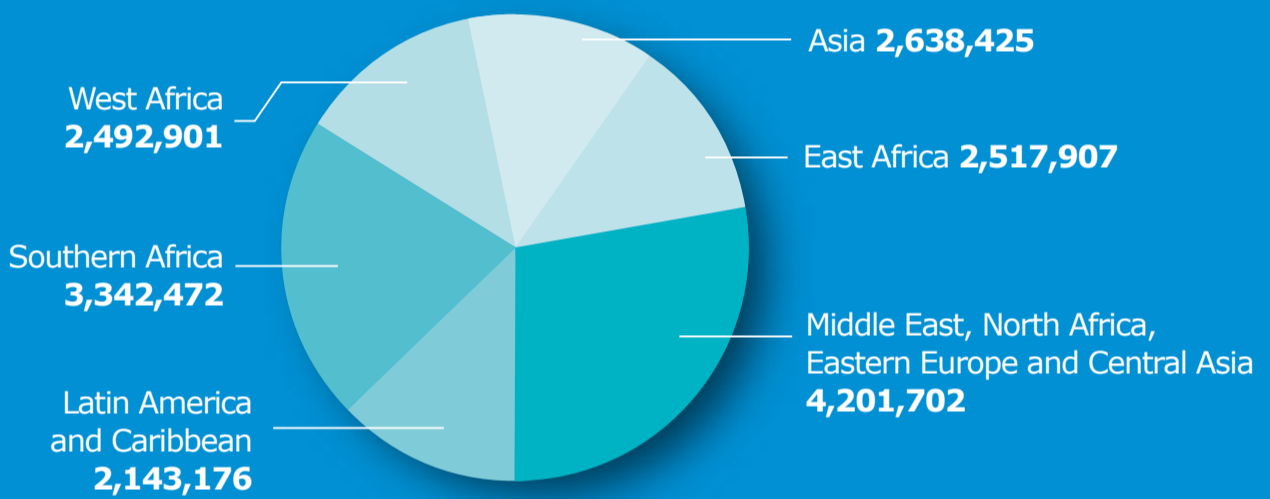
Technical assistance to government programmes indirectly supporting an additional **10 million children**
