**In Numbers**

- 16.2 million people in need of food assistance in El Niño
- 1.5 million potentially food insecure in Haiti by March 2016
- 650,000 estimated food insecure in Lesotho

**Highlights**

- The current El Niño, which began in early 2015, is one of the strongest on record and is affecting the food security of a vast number of people worldwide.
- WFP could be operational and financially ready by March 2016 as a result of the increased food assistance needs across most areas of operations. This includes the need for increased investment in disaster-resilient early warning systems, climate change adaptation and resilience building.

**2015 Timeline:**

- 22 January 2015: WFP EI Niño Declaration
- February: Operational readiness
- October: Operational readiness
- 31 December: Operational readiness
