## **WFP OPweb Portal**

**OPweb** is a joint project between Emergency Preparedness and Support Response Division (OSE), Supply Chain Division (OSC) and Information Technology Division (RMT)

## What is OPweb?

OPweb is WFP's corporate Operations intranet for the management of key operational information in a single location. It is a key resource for all emergency-based Operational Information Management (OIM) and Reporting Officers and it includes Supply Chain and IT operational information.

The platform is built in order to allow every WFP office (Country Offices, Regional Bureaux and interested HQ units) to keep its page updated. OSE's OIM unit supports the other contributors in interacting with the website.

Being the Operations platform, the information on OPweb needs to be kept updated as quick as possible to inform colleagues in a timely manner. Every Country Office, Regional Bureau and HQ unit is responsible to keep the respective page updated and to post correct information on it.

OPweb is a dynamic project, constantly updated to better fit the user requirements. To this scope, OIM develops and updates this guidance every time a new feature is implemented.

## OPweb's Main Features

Home Page - gives the user an overview of all active crises and latest documents and information on WFP operations.

Emergency Page - shows all countries being monitored or involved in a crisis and all related information including links, timeline, maps, crisis documents, country specific documents, dashboard, organigram, etc.


Country Page – allows the user to view information on operations in a given country.


Thematic Page – permit to search for deployment information, templates, best practices, tools, services and other material pertaining to the functional areas.

Search Page - allows the user to search for documents within OPweb and DocuStore.
