WFP Facts and Figures

In 2007, WFP provided 3.3 million tons of food for 86.1 million people in 80 countries worldwide:

62.3 million people in emergency and relief operations and
23.8 million people in development projects

including:

62 million in Africa (72 percent)

53.6 million children

19.3 million children at school

71.6 million women and children

44.9 million women and girls

8.8 million internally displaced people

1.9 million refugees

1.3 million people affected by HIV/AIDS
(in 20 of the 25 highest HIV/AIDS prevalence countries)

FOOD DELIVERED: 3.3 million tons

Contributed in kind: 1.2 million tons
Purchased with cash: 2.1 million tons - of which 80 percent, valued at US\$612 million, was procured in 69 developing countries - enough to feed 45 million people

TOTAL EXPENDITURE: US\$2.97 billion
