Before becoming Treasurer of Mexico, Ms. Casar served as WFP's CFO from 2004-2006, and prior to joining WFP in 2004, she served as CFO of the Banco Nacional de Servicios Fincieros (Bansefi) from 2001.

Ms. Casar's professional financial experience also includes service with Mexico's Ministry of Finance as Director of Financial Analysis, and as Deputy Director of Financial Analysis at the Banking and Securities Commission of Mexico. Ms. Casar has been a Professor and Head of the School of Accounting and Administration at the Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México in Mexico City.

A Mexican national, Ms. Casar was born in Mexico City in 1959. She is a graduate of the Instituto Tecnológico Autónomo de México with a Master in Business Administration, as well as, an undergraduate degree as a Certified Public Accountant. She is married and has two children.
