World Food Programme photographs are copyrighted. In accordance with international copyright laws and the Convention on the Rights of the Child, reproduction of any WFP image implies agreement to these terms:

INTERNAL/EXTERNAL:

Images may not be used in a commercial context, including in co-branding partnerships with commercial companies. WFP does not have subject releases for these uses.

Content may not be changed by digital or any other means, except regular colour management. No pixelation or modification other than regular colour calibration is allowed. Cropping is allowed only with prior approval from the Head of the Photography Unit Mr. Rein Skullerud (address and contact details hereunder). Use must respect the real situation and identity of all human subjects depicted.

The standard dimensions of WFP photos posted on social media platforms and hosting web sites must not exceed the size of 900x600 pixels. This dimension will allow comfortable viewing on monitors but will prevent uses that require high-resolution files.

Use must comply with special protection provisions if the image subject is at risk of harm or discrimination.

All images must be credited as follows: Photo: WFP/Name and Surname of the photographer unless differently instructed by WFP.

WFP images are not available for personal use.

IF SHARING WITH EXTERNAL MEDIA OR OTHER PARTNERS:

ALL images used outside of WFP require written permission by authorized WFP staff. Reproduction rights are granted only for one-time use for the publication and context specified in this order. If use is not specified, rights are not granted.

Any repeat use or use in another context must be additionally requested.

Images may not be archived in any format by any non-WFP entity or individual, including WFP consultants. Recipient agrees to return all hard copies to sender and to delete all images from all electronic storage devices upon completion of authorized reproduction placement.
