## **VENUE:**

The two day Consultation will take place at WFP Headquarters; Via Cesare Giulio Viola, 68, Parco de' Medici – 00148 Roma.



# TRAVEL:

<u>Rome Airports:</u> There are two airports in Rome – Ciampino and Fiumicino. **Fiumicino** is the larger of the two and is also close to WFP HQ with a direct link via the train system.

*Please note:* For all participants who do not possess an EU passport, please be informed that a Visa will be necessary for travel to Rome. We gently remind you to begin any **Visa procedures** as soon as possible.

<u>WFP DaVinci Point</u>: WFP has a service centre in Fiumicino Airport called "the WFP DaVinci Point," with staff that is available to greet participants transiting through Fiumicino and to help ensure that they reach their destinations with ease. The DaVinci Point is able to assist with the following:

- Welcoming
- Problems with flight tickets and check-in
- Luggage loss/delay/damage
- Customs procedures
- Hotel booking
- Local transport
- VIP Lounge / Space for meetings
- Connection to PC
- Access to Internet
