# National Zero Hunger Strategic Reviews

10 completed; 4 on-going; and 2 planned in 2018



## Common Findings:

- Food & Nutrition Security improvements not commensurate with economic growth.
- Persistent inequality resulting in uneven progress on Food & Nutrition Security.
- Domestic food production growth leveling off and less diverse.
- Poorly integrated food systems and vulnerability of smallholder farmers
- Gender, Urbanization and Climate Change are key factors.
