



¹The food security situation in the southern belt of Ethiopia continues to deteriorate. In May, the Government of Ethiopia revised the Humanitarian Requirements Document (HRD) relief beneficiaries up from 5.6 million to 7.8 million, with the additional 2.18 million in Amhara, Oromia and the Southern Nations Nationalities and People's Regions (SNNPR). The number is expected to increase further in the second half of the year.
